Because the protection of our planet is everyone's responsibility and this at all times, we have decided to renovate our hotel with respect for our environment. The success of this initiative depends on your active participation during your stay here.

Towels will only be changed on request. Please leave towels to be changed in the bathtub. Hanging towels will not be changed. You may choose to have your room cleaned upon request only. If you choose to do so, you will receive a discount of 10% per day without maid service. All renovated rooms and apartments are equipped with an energy saving system. This system cuts off the electricity in the room when you are absent; it also cuts off water to avoid leaks. We thank you in advance for taking your cards out of the entryway slots when you leave your room or upon your departure. In the "residence," we have opted for a "Balanced Electricity" contract which allows us to obtain 21% of our energy from renewable sources. Central heating at thermostat 3 and an electric radiator at thermostat 4 maintain a constant temperature of 22°C (71.6°F). Please do not adjust radiator or air conditioning temperature when opening the windows. The temperature of the "pavilion" is regulated with respect to the outside temperature and goes down by 2°C from 2:00AM to 5:00AM and from 11:00AM to 3:00AM. We no longer use individual soaps and bottles of shampoo. This is in an effort to use large, reusable containers. Our air freshener is all natural; it is made entirely from plant extracts and produced in the Franche Comté region of France. Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the premises. In renovating our kitchen, we have chosen optimum energy saving material (induction burners, precise temperature regulators, minimum heat diffusion in the area to limit refrigerator energy consumption). We sort our waste and thank you in advance for not throwing recyclables into the trash. Local laws obligate us to use chlorine in our pool. In order to limit the harmful effects of this product, we ask that you take a shower before entering the pool and avoid using excessive amounts of sunscreen when going in the water. Drinks around the pool area should only be in washable plastic cups – not in bottles, cans or other environmentally unfriendly containers. Breakable bottles and glasses are not permitted. Energy saving light bulbs are being installed in all fixtures and incandescent light bulbs will no longer be used. We offer a selection of organic wines from the Beaujolais. We use local products as often as possible in order to avoid pollution from transportation. We also try to use merchandise that is in recyclable or reusable containers.
